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Camp 2024 Information

- Camp this year for <u>belochki</u> and <u>volchata</u> will be conducted from Sunday, June 23, 2024 to the Saturday, July 6, 2024. We ask that all parents arrive no earlier than 12noon on Sunday June 23rd, help with the camp set up and not leave until the work is complete. Please note that only camp staff are allowed on premises prior to the 12noon start time. The first meal to be served in camp will be dinner on Sunday, June 23rd. Please provide your camper with breakfast and lunch if needed.
- 2. <u>Razvedchiki</u> and <u>Razvedchitsi</u> camp will be in Laytonville from Saturday, June 29 Saturday, July 6. If not backpacking with DNN before, please arrive by 9am on Saturday, June 29th in Laytonville.
- 3. Camp directions: Take 101 North from San Francisco to Laytonville (approximately 170 miles). Once in Laytonville, turn left on Branscomb Road. Go 9 miles along Branscomb until you see a green "St. George Pathfinders" sign on your left. Turn left into the driveway. *Please note: all mail should be addressed to the address below (general delivery no longer accepted)*.

- 4. Packing list will be provided prior to camp once registration is verified.
- 5. Parental Release & Consent for Medical and Surgical Care form must be completed (if you have not already submitted it with your annual dues). Each child must have medical insurance and a copy of their insurance card on file in order to attend camp.
- 6. Sign-up for camp ends June 15th. Please make checks payable to St. George Pathfinders and mail to St. George Pathfinders, c/o Irene Motoviloff, 2508 Poppy Drive, Burlingame, CA 94010. - 7. We ask that parents leave all cars in the designated parking lot and do not drive across the bridge into camp area. Absolutely no alcohol, drugs, firearms, dogs or other animals allowed on camp premises.
- 8. Please keep in mind that camp ends on Saturday, July 6, 2022 at 10:00 am. Campers and parents should not leave until camps and inventory are put away and cleaned up. Those leaving early will be subject to an additional cleaning fee. Remember, the staff are composed of unpaid volunteers, and at the end of a busy 2 weeks, need your help in shutting/closing down camp.

2. Financial Charge:

No financial charge shall be made to the organization for transportation by private vehicle.

3. Number of Passengers (excluding driver):

The number of passengers transported shall not exceed what is legally permissible. Drivers shall place all children securely restrained in back seat. Occupants in front passenger seat should be as far back as possible from passenger airbags. Children shall not ride in back of pickups or motor vehicles not designated for passenger seating with seatbelts.
